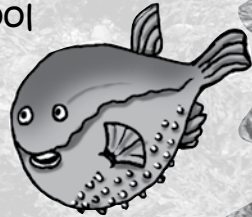


# Seashore Activities

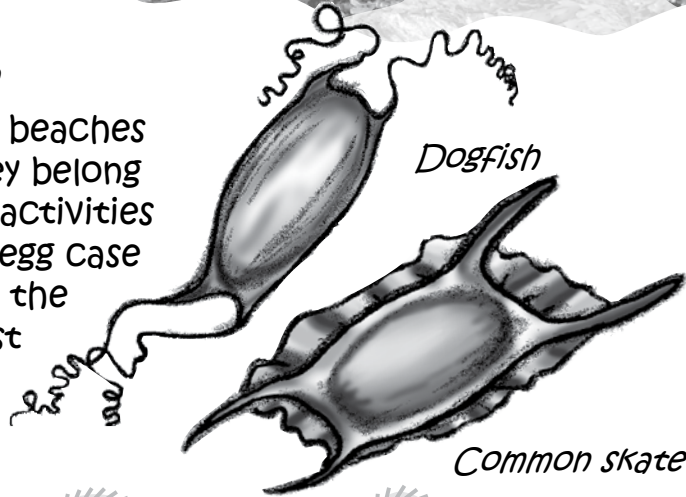


## SIGNS OF SHARKS AND RAYS ON BEACHES

## SEASHORE MEMORY GAME



You need: a small notepad or block of post-it notes with pull-off sheets of paper, a pen or pencil, and one or more friends to play with when you have made the game.

### Making the game

Using our pictures above as a guide, draw a simple fish on the top sheet and then pull the sheet off. Draw another fish just like it on the next sheet and pull that off too. Draw a crab on the next two sheets. Keep going until you have

drawn and torn off two sea anemones, two sea urchins, two starfish and two pieces of seaweed. Keep going with more sea creatures if you want to make the game harder.

### How to play

When you have taken all your drawings off the notepad, turn them all over and mix them up. Take turns to turn two pictures over, remember where they were and then turn them back again. When you turn over two the same you can take them. The person who ends up with the most is the winner.
