

# Looe Island Covid-19 trip safety information

We look forward to welcoming visitors to the nature reserve but with Covid-19 things may be a little different to usual. To help you prepare for your visit, please read the following:

- **Please call the boatman on 07814 264514 to book your trip** (no texts or messages)
- Numbers of **passengers** on boat **restricted to 5 from one family** or a **maximum of 4 individuals**
- Return boat fee (paid to boatman): **£10 per adult and £5 per child** (aged 10 or under). Landing fee (paid on island): **£4 per adult and £1 per child** (aged 10 or under). Please bring **correct money**.

## What to expect from your trip

Apologies - limited assistance to get on/off boat. If you need assistance please delay your trip until we can offer more help.

We suggest your own **bring hand sanitiser** (and possibly face covering/mask)

Please **bring correct money** and you will be asked to place it in an honesty box. Soon we hope to have a card reader so that payments can be contactless

There will **be no access to the visitor centre, bird hide or small Jetty**.

Remember there is **no drinking water, nor refreshments/snacks on the island** – please bring your own supplies

Please **take all your waste/recycling home** with you – we suggest bringing your own waste bag.

When on the island, one person from each visitor group will be asked to leave **contact details** for NHS **Test and Trace** campaign

## Public Boat Trip Times

The table below gives a schedule of possible boat trips to Looe Island Nature Reserve.

All times are approximate and will be subject to weather conditions/sea state and demand.

Up to date information of ferry times for the day will be displayed on the Looe Island Boat Trip information board. The board can be found on the quayside by the floating pontoon and lifeboat station, East Looe. This is also where you will board the boat, Moonraker. Please note that all trips are bookable by phone. Please call the boatman, Dave Butters on 07814 264514 (sorry no texts or messages).

The crossing takes about 15 minutes and visitors will have around 2 hours on the island. There is a fee paid directly to the boatman and a landing fee paid once you are on the island. Numbers of passengers on boat are currently restricted to 5 from one family or a maximum of 4 individuals. Return boat fee (paid to boatman) is £10 per adult and £5 per child (aged 10 or under). Landing fee (paid on island):£4 per adult and £1 per child (aged 10 or under). Please bring correct money.
