

Prisk Cove is located at the mouth of the Helford River, with an interesting mix of both Estuarine and exposed shore species. An in-depth quadrat survey and walkover survey were carried out, as well as a 10 minute Net sweep Fish Survey in the lagoon.







Hannafore is a diverse, large area of rocky shore located at Looe, within the Looe and Whitsand bay Marine Conservation Zone. we carried out a detailed quadrat survey, a walkover, and a sweep net fish survey, and met lots of new volunteers!






