



Clay Hedgehogs



You Will Need:

A collection of very small sticks



Clay



This creative activity uses natural resources to encourage young people to be imaginative. There is a guide on how to make a hedgehog below but why not encourage participants to be creative and explore other methods?

Other creative hedgehog ideas include creating hedgehog mandalas on the forest floor with leaves/twigs, or using mud to paint on paper.

Activity Plan:

1. Use a small lump of clay and roll it into a sphere.



2. Gently pinch one end to a point (this will be the hedgehogs face)



3. Add a small piece of wood or stone to create the eyes.



4. Stick the body full of little twigs to create the spines. The more spines there are the more effective it will look.
